



The Responsibilities of Volunteers at Pirie Community Radio Broadcasters Inc.

You have the responsibility to:

- Have a professional attitude towards your voluntary work.
- Be prompt, reliable and productive with regard to commitments and agreements made with Pirie Community Radio Broadcasters Inc.
- Notify the appropriate person if unable to meet commitments.
- Accept and abide by station rules.
- Understand and adhere to the Codes and maintain familiarity with broadcast laws such as defamation law and the Broadcast Services Act 1992
- Not represent Pirie Community Radio Broadcasters Inc. publicly or commercially unless prior arrangement has been made.
- Not bring in to disrepute the operations, management, staff or other volunteers of Pirie Community Radio Broadcasters Inc.
- Treat technical equipment with due care and respect and to notify technical staff of faults and problems.
- Undertake to complete a minimum of the basic level of training offered at the station if you are intending to work in any area of programming.
- Only use the station resources and equipment in carrying out work for Pirie Community Radio Broadcasters Inc. and not for personal or private purposes.
- Ensure the station has your correct contact details.
- Respect racial and religious backgrounds and the sexual preferences of your co-volunteer workers and work to ensure that Pirie Community Radio Broadcasters Inc. is a safe work place for everyone.
- Contribute to the achievement of a safe, tolerant and equitable working environment by avoiding and assisting in preventing, behaviour which is discriminatory.
